

Pet Licensing in the City of Colorado Springs

The Humane Society of the Pikes Peak Region is a private, nonprofit organization dedicated to the welfare of domesticated animals. The City of Colorado Springs contracts the Humane Society to enforce animal control and licensing ordinances.

PET License Required : Licenses may be obtained from the Humane Society or through some local veterinarians. A current rabies vaccination is required to obtain a license and discounts are offered for spayed or neutered animals, as well as senior citizens. The license is valid one/three year(s) from date of issue and is not transferable. Please notify the Humane Society of any change in ownership or address, or in the event of your pet's death. See below for a license application.

Rabies Inoculations Required : City ordinances require that all dogs and cats be inoculated against rabies by four months of age. Dogs and Cats that reside in the City must also be licensed by five months of age. Dogs are required to wear their issued tags at all times.

APPLICATION FOR PET LICENSE

Licenses for residents of Colorado Springs and all other jurisdictions within El Paso County may be obtained from the Humane Society of the Pikes Peak Region. Current rabies information must be provided to obtain a license, and discounts are offered to spayed or neutered animals, as well as to senior citizens. Rabies information is subject to verification. Please notify the Humane Society of the Pikes Peak Region of any change in ownership or address, or in the event of your pet's death.
