 - a. Adoptions, lost and found pet resources, animal cruelty investigations, spay and neuter surgeries, Trap Neuter Return (TNR) program for feral cats, and more!

 - a. More than 24,000 animals!
- 4. If you lose your pet, what should you do?
 - a. Fill out a lost report and then look in our lost dog and cat kennels to see if your pet is at HSPPR.
- 5. Why do we vaccinate all animals that come through our shelter and have different areas to put animals when they arrive?
 - a. It helps us prevent the spread of diseases among all the unknown pets that come through our door.
- 6. What part of Colorado do our Animal Law Enforcement Officers patrol?
 - a. From Centennial (Southern Denver) to Pueblo. That's 100 miles of Colorado that our officers respond to!
- 7. What is one thing that our Animal Law Enforcement Officers investigate?
 - Our officers investigate animal cruelty and neglect, dangerous animals, dogs at large, and noisy animal complaints just to name a few.
- 8. How many calls for service does our Animal Law Enforcement department get a year?
 - a. 1,000-10,000 calls
